## PROCESSING FINANCIAL AID

Financial aid documentation is completed during June, July and August.

Upon acceptance and payment of the seat fee for the MTEC program, students will be contacted to process financial aid.

Students must complete the FAFSA to be considered for financial aid. Unless exceptional circumstances prevail, applicants should have the FAFSA submitted by June 15 and no later than July 1 prior to the start of a program in August.

The MTEC School Code of 012904 must be on the FAFSA application in order for the school to electronically receive the results (Student Aid Report).

The FAFSA application will generate a confirmation e-mail from Federal Student Aid with an anticipated Pell Grant award amount. If no amount is indicated, you are ineligible for a Pell Grant or your application is incomplete and/or inaccurate. All amounts are estimated until finalizing documents with the financial aid advisor at MTEC.

Students with a FAFSA EFC (Expected Family Contribution) in excess of approximately 5800 are ineligible for Pell Grant funding and will not need to communicate with the financial aid advisor.

MTEC does not disburse loans.

Once accepted in the program, you will be contacted by the financial aid advisor if you are Pell eligible. For this reason, it is very important that the legal name used on the FAFSA match the name provided to MTEC on an application. Please ensure that phone numbers and email addresses are correct.
