All Monongalia County Schools' students

The West Virginia Department of Education requires that all West Virginia counties with orange (16-24 daily cases per 100,000 people) and red (25+ daily cases per 100,000 people) levels of COVID-19 incidence begin the 2020-2021 school year with remote learning Sept. 8-Sept. 11.

Monongalia County's current daily COVID-19 cases metric as of 9 p.m., Saturday, Sept. 5 is **30.98**, according to the West Virginia Department of Health & Human Services, placing it in the red level and requiring remote learning.

The WVDE will issue updated county-by-county COVID-19 status alerts for the coming week based on each county's current COVID-19 incidence at 9 p.m. every Saturday throughout the pandemic.

As essential personnel as defined by Gov. Justice, all Monongalia County Schools staff will report to their buildings according to their regular schedules Sept. 8-Sept. 11.
